A variety of two-in-one options



"We're currently performing breast augmentations using fat transfer, which removes the need for implants and provides a whole new opportunity for select patients," says Dr. Kotis. "We use liposuction techniques to remove fat from an area of the patient's body and then harvest it for replacement back into the patient's breasts. A good candidate is a woman who wants mild fullness—an increase of one cup size only. It's basically two procedures in one, and patients have been thrilled with the results." When focusing on the midsection, Dr. Kotis has developed what his practice calls the "Slim Line Abdominoplasty" to give his patients a two-in-one tummy tuck. "Not only do I tighten the muscles in the midline, but I also tighten the muscles on the horizontal side by the love handles to give more of a V-shaped look for a trimmer abdomen. It accentuates the hip area and patients love that."
